

Edge of Dock Leveler Worksheet

IMPORTANT: Pallet Jacks are not recommended for use with dock levelers. However, in some cases they may be used to accommodate 3" above dock and 3" below dock applications.

NOTE: To achieve the occasional use of a +/-5" range, we recommend a gas or propane forklift. The dock leveler should not be used for frequent use +/-5".
